Resolution Initiating The Process To Approve a Cannabis Ordinance Regulating the Establishment and Operation of Cannabis Businesses Within the City of Hayward

- 1) The City Council approves moving forward with the process to Create and Ordinance aligning with Minnesota Statute Chapter 342, which allows local governments to impose reasonable restrictions on the time, place, and manner of cannabis business operations.
- 2) The City Clerk is authorized to initiate the necessary steps, including legal review, public hearings, and drafting of proposed amendments.
- 3) The City Council encourages community engagement throughout this process, including seeking input from residents, businesses, and other stakeholders.
- 4) The City Council directs the City Attorney to provide legal guidance and draft any necessary legal ordinances and/or resolution related to the proposed amendments.
- 5) The City Council anticipates that the an ordinance, described here within will enhance governance, promote transparency, and better serve the interests of our constituents.

Councilmember Bangert introduced Resolution 2025-6, a resolution approving that the city moves forward with initiating the process to approve a cannabis ordinance aligning with Minnesota Statute Chapter 342, which allows local governments to impose reasonable restrictions on the time, place, and manner of cannabis business operations in City of Hayward, Minnesota. Councilor Dolph seconded. Resolution 2025-6 passed unanimously.
