

**RESOLUTION 2025-13  
CITY OF HAYWARD, FREEBORN COUNTY,  
STATE OF MINNESOTA**

*A Resolution Adopting the Provisions of the Minnesota Basic Code of Ordinances §§ 113.03–113.07 for the Regulation of Peddlers and Transient Merchants*

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hayward, Minnesota, recognizes the need to regulate peddlers and transient merchants in order to protect public safety, ensure fair commercial practices, and preserve the peace and welfare of the community; and


**WHEREAS**, the Minnesota Basic Code of Ordinances (MBC), as published by the League of Minnesota Cities, provides model regulatory provisions in §§ 113.03 through 113.07 that address licensing, operational standards, enforcement, and penalties for peddlers and transient merchants; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds these provisions to be appropriate and effective for local adoption, and wishes to formally incorporate them into its municipal regulatory framework;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Hayward, Minnesota, as follows:

1. Adoption of MBC §§ 113.03–113.07. The City hereby adopts the provisions of the Minnesota Basic Code of Ordinances §§ 113.03 through 113.07, inclusive, as the official regulations governing peddlers and transient merchants within the City of Hayward.
2. Enforcement and Administration. The City Clerk and designated enforcement personnel are authorized to administer and enforce the provisions of §§ 113.03–113.07, including the issuance of licenses, collection of fees, and imposition of penalties as provided therein.
3. Conflict and Supersession. Any existing ordinances or policies of the City that conflict with the provisions of §§ 113.03–113.07 are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
4. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective upon its passage and approval, and the adopted provisions shall be enforceable within the City of Hayward as of that date.
